



Preschool Supported Program (PSP)

The Preschool Supported Program (PSP) focuses on the children's development of independence, routine and effective communication for early learners.

With a play-based approach children explore, engage and participate in specialised learning experiences and activities with their peers. They will immerse in the child led play-based curriculum within the Preschool.

Our goal for this program is to engage the children in a learning environment where they will be encouraged to:

- build connections with peers and educators
- experience positive separation from families
- access a range of Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC)
- participate in routines
- develop independence
- explore and engage in play opportunities
- make choices

Participating in the Preschool Supported Program does not guarantee your child a place in The Briars Preschool program. An official Department for Education, Education Pathways panel process must be adhered to.

To access the Preschool Supported Program your child must have turned 3 years old and have complex communication needs. Please note that priority of access is given to children who are not enrolled in any other service (i.e. Childcare and/or Occasional Care).
